Safe-T-Stop / PlateTronic Testimonial

We had been contemplating purchasing a Brake Tester and a Shaker for our service facility for some time. When we agreed with the RMS that they would inspect our buses on our premises, we needed suitable equipment. We looked at the various types of equipment on offer including all heavy roller brake test machines. We decided to install the locally built PlateTronic Plate Brake Tester.

Some of our reasons are as follows:

- It was much easier to install as we didn't have the room to 'block' a complete service pit to install a roller.
- The PlateTronic brake tester is installed outside which means we lose no valuable working space, and by doing this, the brake tester is always accessible to do a brake test.
- The Plate Brake Tester also seemed much easier and safer to use compared to the roller testers which was a big plus for us from an OH&S point of view.
- The PlateTronic equipment meets all government requirements and the RMS approves it for the regular roadworthy inspection requirements.
- It is locally built by a company that has 25 years of experience and therefore would be no issues if spare parts were required.
- Last, but not least, the price of a PlateTronic is half of that quoted for Roller Brake Test equipment.

I am happy to say that the team from Safe-T-Stop is very knowledgeable in the brake test industry and they have given us great service.

The team from Safe-T-Stop were very helpful with advising us the best possible locations for the installation of the Brake Tester and Play Detector (shaker).
